



Author Agreement for the Work of
_____ entitled,

This agreement is between PriorityONE Publications, publisher, Christina Dixon and Author _____; hereafter referred to as Author.

RIGHTS

As Author, you acknowledge and agree that PriorityONE Publications (P1) acquires no right of ownership to the Work entitled, _____ under this Agreement; that P1 is a provider of limited services only (i.e., printing, book sales, and internet access, webpage on the PriorityONE website and additional items as specified in this agreement).

Traditionally, when you enter into an agreement with a book publisher, you are required to grant some of those rights to the publisher - usually the right "to print, publish and sell the work in book form". However, since you will continue to hold all rights to your work, your agreement and standing with P1 is that of a self-published Author.

As such you will be responsible for the all the cost of publishing your book (*i.e. typesetting, editing, printing, cover design, and marketing materials*). Rest assured that P1 will do all we can to help reduce costs and make publishing your own book a positive experience for you and your potential readers.

WARRANTIES, TERMS AND EXCLUSIVITY

The Author represents and warrants that he or she is the sole Author of the Work submitted and is the owner of the copyright to all of its contents; that he or she has not engaged in plagiarism with respect to the Work; that the Work is accurate in all respects, (i.e., that if non-fiction, it does not misstate any material fact or omit to state any material fact, the result of which would libel any person or result in a false or damaging light); and that the Work does not infringe upon any statutory or common law right of copyright or privacy of any third party; that he or she is owner of any trademarks and/or trade names associated with the Work; that the Work does not constitute obscenity or hate literature and that the Author has the right to enter into this Agreement.

This Agreement is nonexclusive (the Author can enter into other publishing agreements), and either party has the option to terminate the Agreement at any time, with or without cause. If the Agreement is terminated by the Author, P1 must be notified via USPS in writing and sent to PriorityONE Publications, P. O. Box 34722, Detroit, MI 48234. Should P1 choose to terminate this agreement, the Author must be notified via USPS in writing and sent to _____.

However, P1 may not terminate this agreement prior to the Author's receipt of the first printing.

While producing your book with P1 you are free to publish or print your book with as many publishers, agents, and other firms as you like. However, when doing so, you MUST use an International Standard Book Number (ISBN) registered with that publishing company. You will not be permitted to use P1 registered ISBN's when using other firms or printers. Should you choose to discontinue using the edition(s) you publish with P1, you will be required to provide notice of this decision in writing. It is further agreed that should the Author choose to publish with another publisher, the Author MUST notify the publisher of this decision in writing.

INDEMNITIES

The Author agrees to indemnify P1 and its employees, representatives, successors and assigns of and from all and any manner of claims, liabilities, damages, expenses (including reasonable attorney’s fees), awards, and judgments resulting from claims of (i) third parties regarding ownership, libel, slander, plagiarism, privacy, misappropriation, and similar claims arising from publications of the Work; (ii) Author’s breach of any warranty in the Agreement. P1 agrees to notify the Author promptly of any claim for indemnity under this Agreement between P1 and a third party regarding a claim covered by the indemnity provisions of the Agreement shall be subject to approval of the Author, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.

SERVICES PROVIDED BY PriorityONE Publications

Since the Author holds rights to the Works submitted, the Author is free to order additional printed copies of the Work as often or as little as they choose. PriorityONE Publications agrees to provide the Author printing of said Work at 60% off the retail price for each printing order for quantities less than 250 books. Quantities of 251-499 books the discount will be 65%. Quantities of 500-999 will receive a discount of 70% and for quantities 1,000-1,999 books the Author will receive a 75% discount. Quantities over 2,000 books will be eligible for larger discounts and will be quoted at the time order is placed. Discounts DO NOT include shipping.

Example: Chart is estimated charges for 500 6x9, 164 page book with \$14.99 retail cost.

It is agreed that ALL the aforementioned costs will be PAID IN FULL prior to PriorityONE Publications printing the number of books ordered.

Minimum services provided include but are not limited to the following:

- Listing on Amazon.com
- Registration with Books in Print
- ISBN assignment
- Processing of orders (i.e., telephone, fax, internet, etc.)
- Webpage listing
- Availability to major bookstores (i.e., Books-A-Million, Barnes & Nobles, etc.) and libraries via registration at R. R. Bowker, Ingram Group and Baker & Taylor.

All other services will be provided as outlined in PriorityONE Publishing Package chosen by the Author. By placing their initials beside it, the Author has chosen the package selected below:

BOOK’S AVAILABILITY

By registering with P1, others who wish to purchase your book will be able to do so by PriorityONE Publications telephone, fax, USPS, email and via the internet on the P1 website, Amazon.com, and Barnes and Noble.com and other book retailers made .

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

As Publisher:

P1 has all the aforementioned rights and responsibilities that fall into the category of publisher previously and hereafter mentioned (including printing copies of said works should it choose to do so).

P1 will provide cover design, implementation of edits made by professional editor, interior layout and typesetting design of inside pages as part of its publishing packages.

P1 will process all book store orders. Orders received by P1 via USPS, fax, email, and book stores and distributors will be processed within 3 business days of receiving them.

P1 will process all orders for bookstores, libraries and retail outlets through its national and international distributors and wholesalers.

P1 will be responsible for making quarterly royalties payments as outlined in this document.

Additional Publishing Services:

Should author's completed work exceed 200 pages, additional charges will be incurred at the rate of \$65/hour. Should work require additional pages P1 MUST notify the author prior to the implementation of additional services, with an estimate of hours needed to facilitate further negotiation and author approval.

Upon completion of services a detailed invoice will be provided specifying itemized and total costs within 5 business days.

MARKETING AND ROYALTIES

It is understood that the Author on this project has the right to sell books at seminars, book signings, conferences, etc. for which they appear.

It is further understood that the sales from events of this type will be the sole property of the Author arranging said event that since author will be providing books for the event, no compensation with regard to PriorityONE Publications is required.

It is further understood that PriorityONE Publications will pay royalties to the Author of said Work in the following manner:

Royalties will only be received from sales which come to the PriorityONE Publications office through Amazon.com, book store orders, and orders by phone, fax, electronic or USPS mail.

Said royalties will be paid quarterly at the rate of 10% of list price to be payable by the 15th of the month following each quarter. For example the first quarter of the year ends in March 31st. This means that PriorityONE Publications will process Author royalties for the first quarter on or before April 15th. Said royalties will be sent via USPS.

Example:

# of Books Sold in Quarter	Retail List Price	Royalties @ 10%
50	\$14.99 x 50 = \$749.50	\$749.50 x 10% = \$74.95
